



PLAYOFF HISTORY

* This is the ninth all-time postseason meeting between the franchises (EDM: 6-2; LAK: 2-6) and second in as many years. The others: [2022 First Round](#), [1992 Division Semifinals](#), [1991 Division Finals](#), [1990 Division Finals](#), [1989 Division Semifinals](#), [1987 Division Semifinals](#), [1985 Division Semifinals](#) and [1982 Division Semifinals](#).

2022 First Round Recap: The first playoff series between the Oilers and Kings in 30 years saw **Connor McDavid** match the NHL record for most multi-point games in a single round (6). McDavid's 14 points overall equaled the most by any player in the first round in 29 years and trailed only **Mario Lemieux** (17 in 1992) and **Wayne Gretzky** (15 in 1987) for the [most ever in an opening round](#). **Evander Kane** (7 G) played a complimentary role by posting the highest single-series goal total by an Oilers player in 31 years. The clubs met in a Game 7 for the second time, following the Kings' victory in the 1989 Division Semifinals when Gretzky led Los Angeles past his former club.

#NHLSTATS NOTABLES

* Sixty-seven players have played for both franchises (min. 1 GP in regular-season or playoffs), including 20 who have skated for each club during the Stanley Cup Playoffs.

* Thirty players who competed in the 2022 First Round series between the Kings (16) and Oilers (14) could play again this year, though both neither team has the same starting goaltender.

* The last time two clubs met in consecutive postseasons *without returning any starting goaltenders* from the first meeting was 2007 when the Sharks and Predators clashed for the second straight year; **Evgeni Nabokov** started each contest for San Jose (after **Vesa Toskala** had in 2006) while **Tomas Vokoun** did so for Nashville (in place of **Chris Mason** the year prior).

* Only eight series on record (since 1977-78) have involved two teams that had a power-play percentage of 25.0% or higher during the regular season (all others occurred from 1979 to 1984). One other confirmed 2023 First Round matchup will also meet these criteria (TOR vs. TBL).
