

PLAYOFF HISTORY

- * This is the second postseason meeting between the franchises, following a six-game triumph by the Stars in the 2016 First Round.
- * 2016 First Round Recap: Dallas opened up the series winning the first two games at home, only allowing one goal over both games with game-winning goals from current Stars' players Radek Faska and Jamie Benn. The home winning ways continued as the Wild won game three due to three points from Jason Pominville in a 5-3 effort. The road team ended up winning each of the next three games, which were all decided by one goal and the series was capped off with current Wild defensemen, Alex Goligoski, scoring the series clinching goal in game six for the Stars in a 5-4 victory at Excel Energy Center. The series finished with five of the six games being decided by one goal or two goals with an empty netter.
