



PLAYOFF HISTORY

* This is the second all-time postseason meeting between the franchises. The Lightning defeated the Maple Leafs in seven games in the [First Round last year](#).

* **2022 First Round Recap:** With two of the top eight offenses from the regular season facing off, each of the first four games saw either the Maple Leafs or Lightning score five or more goals – just the fifth such series since 1996. In Game 5, **Auston Matthews** scored the go-ahead, game-winning goal to give Toronto its third multi-goal comeback victory in the playoffs since 2004 and put the club within one win of its first series triumph in that same time frame. The two-time defending Stanley Cup champions responded with a comeback victory of their own in Game 6 as **Brayden Point** netted the third overtime goal of his NHL career to match the franchise record. The winner-take-all showdown saw Mississauga, Ont., native **Nicholas Paul** (2-0—2) match a Lightning benchmark for goals in a Game 7 and give the club its ninth consecutive series win. It was the only series in the 2022 First Round to feature a 100-point scorer on each side (TBL: **Steven Stamkos**; TOR: **Auston Matthews**).

* Forty-four players have played for both franchises (min. 1 GP in regular-season or playoffs), including 11 who have skated for each club during the Stanley Cup Playoffs.

* Toronto and Tampa Bay have been headed toward a First Round matchup for 114 consecutive days – the teams have been No. 2 and No. 3 in the Atlantic Division (regardless of order) every day since Dec. 8.

* This could become the ninth series on record (since 1977-78) to feature two teams who had a power-play percentage of 25.0% or higher during the regular season (all others occurred from 1979 to 1984). The only such meeting in that span during the opening round was in 1981 Preliminary Round between the Islanders (29.3%) and Maple Leafs (25.3%).
