\* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 2nd) needs 67 goals to tie Wayne Gretzky (894) for the most in NHL history.

\* Steven Stamkos (TBL; 38th) is within reach of the top 30 in NHL history.

Most Goals, Career, Including Playoffs

\* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 899) needs one goal for 900 in his career.

\* Sidney Crosby (PIT; 24th) is within reach of the top 20 in NHL history.

\* Steven Stamkos (TBL; 39th) needs 32 to reach 600 in his career.

Most Goals, Defenseman, Career

\* **Brent Burns** (CAR; 250) needs 15 goals to overtake **Nicklas Lidstrom** (264) for eighth place among defensemen in NHL history. Burns is the active leader among blueliners.

Assists

Most Assists, Career

\* Sidney Crosby (PIT; 15th) needs 38 assists to become the 14th player in NHL history to record 1,000.

Points

Most Points, Career

\* Sidney Crosby (PIT; 15th) is 66 points from entering the top 10 in NHL history.

\* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 16th) needs three points to become the 16th player in NHL history to record 1,500.

Most Points, Career, Including Playoffs

\* **Sidney Crosby** (PIT; 1,725) and **Alex Ovechkin** (WSH; 1,638) rank 13th and 16th, respectively, and can each climb multiple spots.

Most Points, Defensemen, Career

\* Brent Burns (CAR; 847) can become the 13th defenseman in League history to record 900 career points.

Special Teams (Since 1933-34) Most Power-Play Goals, Career

\* All-time leader **Alex Ovechkin** (WSH; 300) is the only player in NHL history to record 300 power-play goals.

\* Steven Stamkos (TBL; t-20th) needs two power-play goals to become the 20th player to accumulate 200 in his career.

Most Shorthanded Goals, Career

\* Brad Marchand (BOS; 33) is tied for 14th place in NHL history and sits two back for a share of ninth place.

#### Most 40-Goal Season, Career

\* **Steven Stamkos** (TBL; 6) can record his seventh 40-goal season, a feat accomplished by 17 players in NHL history (**Alex Ovechkin**, 13, is the only other active player to do so).

## Most 40-Goal Seasons, Consecutive

\* **Auston Matthews** (TOR; t-20th) can become the second active player to record five consecutive 40-goal seasons – only **Alex Ovechkin** (WSH; 5 from 2005-06 – 2009-10) has done so.

#### Most 50-Goal Seasons, Career

\* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 9) is tied with Mike Bossy (9) and Wayne Gretzky (9) for the most career 50-goal seasons in NHL history.

\* Leon DraisaitI (EDM; 3) can become the 15th player in NHL history to record four 50-goal seasons and the second active to do so alongside Alex Ovechkin (9).

#### Most 50-Goal Season, Consecutive

\* Leon Draisaitl (EDM; 2) can join Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 3 from 2013-14 – 2015-16 & 2007-08 – 2009-10) as the second active player to record three consecutive 50-goal seasons.

#### Most 100-Point Seasons, Career

\* **Connor McDavid** (EDM; 6) is tied with **Sidney Crosby** (PIT; 6) for the most 100-point seasons among active players. Only five players in NHL history have had seven such campaigns.

#### Most 100-Point Seasons, Consecutive

\* **Connor McDavid** can establish a career best with his fourth consecutive 100-point season, a feat last achieved by **Steve Yzerman** (6; 1987-88 – 1992-93) and **Brett Hull** (4; 1989-90 – 1992-93).

Hat Tricks

Most Hat Tricks, Career

\* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 30) needs two hat tricks to match Phil Esposito for the fifth most in NHL history.

Game-Winning Goals

Most Game-Winning Goals, Career

\* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 124) trails only Jaromir Jagr (135) for the most game-winning goals in NHL history.

## Most Game-Winning Goals, Career, Including Playoffs

\* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 134) is tied with Brett Hull (134) for second most in NHL history and trailing only Jaromir Jagr (151).

## Most Game-Winning Goals, Defenseman, Career

\* **Brent Burns** (CAR; 42) needs one game-winning goal to tie **Paul Coffey** (43) for fifth place in NHL history among defensemen and is within reach of climbing higher on the all-time list.

# Multi-Goal/Assist/Point Games, Career

Multi-Goal Games

\* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 168) has the second most in NHL history behind Wayne Gretzky (189).

\* Sidney Crosby (PIT; 95) needs five to become the 25th player in NHL history to record 100 such outings.

#### **Multi-Point Games**

\* **Sidney Crosby** (PIT; 452) and **Alex Ovechkin** (WSH; 420) rank 11th and 12th, respectively, with Crosby five back of tying Phil Esposito (457) for 10th place in NHL history.

#### Most Games Played, Career

\* **Marc-Andre Fleury** (MIN; 994 GP) needs six games to become the fourth goaltender in NHL history to reach the 1,000-game milestone. He is 35 contests shy of matching **Patrick Roy** (1,029 GP) for the third-most all time.

\* Jonathan Quick (NYR; 760 GP) needs 40 games to become the 17th goaltender to play in 800 career contests.

## Most Minutes Played, Career

\* Marc-Andre Fleury (MIN; 57,584:07) is within reach of the top three in NHL history.

## Most Wins, Career

\* Marc-Andre Fleury (MIN; 547) needs five wins to surpass Patrick Roy (551) for the second most in NHL history.

\* Jonathan Quick (NYR; 380) needs 12 wins to surpass Ryan Miller (391) for the most wins by a U.S.-born goaltender.

# Most Shutouts, Career

\* **Marc-Andre Fleury** (MIN; 12th) needs three shutouts to move into a tie with **Ed Belfour** (76) and **Tony Esposito** (76) for the 10th most in NHL history.

\* Jonathan Quick (NYR; 60) is one shutout from tying Turk Broda (61) for 18th and four from matching Henrik Lundqvist (64) for 17th on the all-time list.

# Win Plateaus

## Most 30-Win Seasons, Career

\* Marc-Andre Fleury (MIN; 9) is tied with Ed Belfour (9) for the fourth-most 30-win seasons in NHL history, behind Martin Brodeur (14), Patrick Roy (13) and Henrik Lundqvist (11).

# Most 30-Win Seasons, Consecutive

\* **Andrei Vasilevskiy** (TBL; 6) can become the ninth goaltender in NHL history – and first in more than a decade – to record at least seven consecutive 30-win seasons.

\* Marc-Andre Fleury (65) is the all-time leader in shootout wins among goaltenders.

\* Jonathan Quick (NYR; 5th) needs one victoriy to tie Roberto Luongo (52) for the fourth-most in NHL history.

\* **Paul Maurice** (FLA; 1,785 GC) is 15 games from joining **Scotty Bowman** (2,141 GC) and **Barry Trotz** (1,812 GC) as the only head coaches to serve at least 1,800 regular-season games.

\* **John Tortorella** (PHI; 1,484 GC) and **Peter Laviolette** (NYR; 1,447 GC) are 16 and 53 contests, respectively, from the 1,500-game milestone.

Wins

\* **Peter Laviolette** (NYR; 765) is within reach of becoming the seventh head coach in NHL history to earn 800 career regular-season wins. **Lindy Ruff** (NJD; 842) and **Paul Maurice** (FLA; 829) are the only active head coaches to achieve the milestone.

\* John Tortorella (PHI; 714) needs eight wins to move into a tie with Alain Vigneault (722) for the 10th most victories in NHL history.

\* **Todd McLellan** (LAK; 586) and **Peter DeBoer** (DAL; 572) need 14 and 28 wins, respectively, to earn their 600th career victory, a feat achieved by 22 head coaches to date.

\* Jon Cooper (TBL; 489) is 11 victories shy of the 500-win milestone.

\* **Clayton Keller** (140-220—360) needs 40 points to become the seventh player in franchise history to record 400. He is also 26 assists shy of leapfrogging three players and tying Keith Yandle (246) for 10th most.

\* **Clayton Keller** (6) needs one <u>overtime goal</u> to tie Oliver Ekman-Larsson (7) for second place and five to tie Shane Doan (11) for the most in Coyotes/Jets history.

Boston Bruins Franchise History

\* Brad Marchand (965) needs 35 games to become the eighth player to play in 1,000 for the Bruins.



\* **Brad Marchand** (379) needs 21 <u>goals</u> to reach 400 and join Johnny Bucyk (545), Phil Esposito (459), Patrice Bergeron (427) and Rick Middleton (402) as the only players to reach the mark in franchise history.

\* **Brad Marchand** (881) is 19 <u>points</u> shy from 900 with Boston, a feat accomplished by four other players in team history. Marchand would surpass Rick Middleton (898) and Bobby Orr (888) on his way to the milestone. **David Pastrnak** (646) needs 28 points to equal Ken Hodge (674) in 10th place.

\* **David Pastrnak** (313) is 31 <u>goals</u> shy of matching Cam Neely (344) for seventh place. Pastrnak (9) needs one <u>overtime goal</u> to tie Glenn Murray and Dit Clapper (each w/ 10) for second behind Brad Marchand (17).

\* **Charlie McAvoy** (199) needs 1 <u>assist</u> to become the 10th defenseman to record 200. McAvoy (14) is one <u>game-winning goal</u> from tying Flash Hollett (15) for fifth place among defensemen.

\* **Rasmus Dahlin** (50) needs four <u>goals</u> to match Doug Bodger (54) for fifth and five to equal Alexei Zhitnik (55) for fourth among blueliners in Sabres history. Dahlin needs one <u>assist</u> to become the seventh defenseman to earn 200 with the club.

\* Rasmus Dahlin (50-199—249) can leapfrog three players and move into third place in <u>points</u> among blueliners.

\* **Rasmus Dahlin** (54) needs one <u>multi-point</u> game to tie Jerry Korab (55) for third and three to equal Doug Bodger (57) for second among defensemen.

\* **Mikael Backlund** (16) needs one <u>shorthanded</u> goal to overtake Kent Nilsson (16) for sole possession of second behind Theo Fleury (28).

\* Jacob Markstrom (86) needs 14 wins to become the fifth goaltender to record 100 victories with the Flames.

\* Jacob Markstrom (13) needs one shutout to surpass Mike Vernon (13) for sole possession of third place

\* **Sebastian Aho** (223) needs 27 goals to move into a tie with Kevin Dineen (250) for third on the franchise alltime list.

\* **Sebastain Aho** (223-261—484) needs 16 <u>points</u> to join three others with 500 points as a member of the Hurricanes/Whalers. **Jordan Staal** (156-247—403) needs one point to pass Pat Verbeek (403) for sole possession of seventh.

\* **Sebastian Aho** (46) needs one <u>game-winning goals</u> to tie Eric Staal (47) for second behind Ron Francis (57) for the most in franchise history.

\* **Jaccob Slavin** (46) needs five <u>goals</u> to tie Mark Howe and Glen Wesley (each w/ 51) for second among blueliners.

\* **Jaccob Slavin** (46-200—246) needs 12 points to tie Justin Faulk (258) for the most by a blueliner. Slavin (3) also needs one <u>overtime goal</u> to take sole possession for the most in franchise history among defensemen.

\* **Jamie Benn** (494) needs 6 <u>assists</u> to join Mike Modano (802) and Neal Broten (593) as the only players with 500 with the franchise. Benn (366-494—860) is also seven <u>points</u> shy of Broten (867) for second in Stars/North Stars history.

\* Tyler Seguin (46) needs one multi-goal games to tie Bill Goldsworthy (47) for fourth most in franchise history.



\* Jake Oettinger (86) needs 14 wins to earn his 100th with the club, a feat achieved by seven goaltenders to date.
