- * The Kraken will face the reigning Stanley Cup champion Golden Knights in the 2024 Discover NHL Winter Classic at T-Mobile Park, home of MLB's Seattle Mariners, on Monday, Jan. 1 (12 p.m. PT / 3 p.m. ET, TNT, TruTV, Max, SN, TVAS).
- * Seattle and Vegas the League's two newest franchises are playing in their first and second outdoor games in franchise history, respectively.
- * The Kraken will make their outdoor game debut, doing so in a venue located just three miles from Climate Pledge Arena. Seattle will become the 29th NHL franchise to contest an outdoor game.
- * The Golden Knights will play their second outdoor game, following a loss to the Colorado Avalanche in the 2021 NHL Outdoors at Lake Tahoe. Reigning Stanley Cup champions are 5-1-0 in outdoor games.
- * Seattle and Vegas debuted in 2021-22 and 2017-18, respectively, and have won a combined 61 playoff games, 12 postseason series and one Stanley Cup during their short NHL tenures. The Golden Knights enjoyed <u>unprecedented success during their inaugural season</u>, while the Kraken had 46 wins and 100 points in 2022-23 (the best improvements by an NHL franchise from its first to second season and <u>among the biggest year-over-year point improvements by any team in League history</u>).
- * Seattle will become the youngest NHL franchise to compete in an outdoor game, eclipsing Vegas (which was contesting its fourth season in 2021).
- * The first outdoor game between NHL teams took place less than two miles from the Golden Knights' home arena on Sept. 27, 1991, with the Los Angeles Kings scoring five unanswered goals to overcome a 2-0 deficit and earn a preseason win against the New York Rangers on a rink built over the Caesars Palace parking lot.

SEATTLE SKRAKEN

- * Kailer Yamamoto (Spokane, Wash.) is set to become the 68th different NHL player to dress for an outdoor game in his birth state or province, and the fourth among those born outside of Canada, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota or New York. He can join Matt Nieto (Long Beach, Calif.) in the 2015 Stadium Series at Levi's Stadium as well as Chris Chelios (Chicago, Ill.) and Brett Lebda (Buffalo Grove, Ill.) in the 2009 Winter Classic at Wrigley Field.
- * Matty Beniers is set to become the sixth reigning Calder Memorial Trophy winner to skate in an outdoor game, following Kirill Kaprizov (2022 WC), Cale Makar (2021 LT), Artemi Panarin (2017 WC), Patrick Kane (2009 WC) and Evgeni Malkin (2008 WC). (Auston Matthews did not dress for the 2018 SS.)

- * Jared McCann, who leads the Kraken in goals this season, is set to contest his second outdoor game and first since playing alongside current teammates **Brian Dumoulin** and **Justin Schultz** with the Pittsburgh Penguins in the 2019 Stadium Series at Lincoln Financial Field. McCann was a member of four different NHL franchises before being claimed by Seattle in the 2021 Expansion Draft and currently is the team's all-time leader in goals and points.
- * Vince Dunn is set to ring in the new year after ranking among the League leaders for goals, assists and points by defensemen in 2023. He won a Stanley Cup alongside current Vegas players Ivan Barbashev and Alex Pietrangelo with the St. Louis Blues in 2019, capped by the team earning a championship-clinching win against current Golden Knights head coach Bruce Cassidy and the Boston Bruins in Game 7 of the Final.
- * **Jordan Eberle** and **Brandon Tanev** are set to contest their first outdoor games since going head-to-head in the 2016 Heritage Classic at Investors Group Field with the Edmonton Oilers and Winnipeg Jets, respectively. **Adam Larsson** also skated with Edmonton during its 3-0 win.
- * Pierre-Edouard Bellemare, Andre Burakovsky and Philipp Grubauer all appeared across from the Golden Knights with the Avalanche during their 3-2 win in the 2021 NHL Outdoors at Lake Tahoe. Burakovsky was on the ice for the game-winning goal, and Grubauer had 27 saves in the victory.
- * Tomas Tatar tallied two points with the Detroit Red Wings in both the 2017 Centennial Classic at Exhibition Stadium and the 2016 Stadium Series at Coors Field. He can become the first player in NHL history to record multiple points in three outdoor games, eclipsing Sean Couturier, Zach Hyman, Nathan MacKinnon, David Pastrnak and Henrik Zetterberg (all 2x).
- * Dave Hakstol was the Philadelphia Flyers' head coach during their 4-2 loss to Dumoulin, Schultz and the Penguins in the 2017 Stadium Series at Heinz Field. One of Hakstol's players and Bellemare's teammates was current Philadelphia forward **Sean Couturier**, whose father, **Sylvain**, scored the game-winning goal for Los Angeles in the 1991 outdoor preseason contest at Caesars Palace in Las Vegas.

VEGAS V GOLDEN KNIGHTS

- * **Jack Eichel**, who is set to contest his second outdoor game and first since skating with the Buffalo Sabres in the 2018 Winter Classic at Citi Field, leads the Golden Knights in points this season. Joining him atop the team's goal-scoring chart are **William Karlsson** and **Jonathan Marchessault** the pair are two of Vegas' five "Misfits" who have played for the franchise since its inaugural season (also **William Carrier**, **Brayden McNabb** and **Shea Theodore**).
- * Eichel is approaching 200 goals for his NHL career. Only **Mark Stone** and Marchessault have scored more career goals among Golden Knights players.
- * Stone skated with the Ottawa Senators in the NHL100 Classic at Lansdowne Park and the Golden Knights in the 2021 NHL Outdoors at Lake Tahoe. He became the first captain in Vegas history just over one month before the latter contest and since has been named a Frank J. Selke Trophy finalist, played in an All-Star Game and scored a Stanley Cupclinching hat trick.
- * The Golden Knights could have as many as 20 Stanley Cup winners in their lineup, including three-time champion **Alec Martinez** (2023 VGK, 2014 LAK and 2012 LAK) and two-time winners **Ivan Barbashev** (2023 VGK and 2019 STL), **Alex Pietrangelo** (2023 VGK and 2019 STL) and **Chandler Stephenson** (2023 VGK and 2018 WSH). The most Stanley Cup winners among to dress for an outdoor game is 19 by the Chicago Blackhawks in the 2014 Stadium Series at Soldier Field, while the most combined Stanley Cup wins is 37 by the Red Wings in the 2009 Winter Classic at Wrigley Field.
- * **Bruce Cassidy** was the Bruins' head coach during their 7-3 win against the Flyers in the 2021 NHL Outdoors at Lake Tahoe and 4-2 victory versus the Blackhawks in the 2019 Winter Classic at Notre Dame Stadium. He can become the second NHL head coach to win each of his first three outdoor games, following **Alain Vigneault** (3-0-0).

BY THE NUMBERS

- Year that current Seattle forward Pierre-Edouard Bellemare was claimed by Vegas (from PHI) in the NHL Expansion Draft, while new teammate Tomas Tatar was traded to the Golden Knights by the Red Wings later that season. They are two of three players to appear in at least one game with both the Kraken and Golden Knights (also Derrick Pouliot).
- Year that Mariners icons **Ken Griffey Jr.** and **Ichiro Suzuki** (who are featured on <u>Kraken goaltender Joey Daccord's Winter Classic mask</u>) were carried off the field at T-Mobile Park on the shoulders of their teammates at the conclusion of the season. Similar occurrences happened in the NHL on May 21, 1979 (when Canadiens forward **Bob Gainey** won the Conn Smythe Trophy), April 21, 1951 (when Toronto Maple Leafs defenseman **Bill Barilko** scored the Stanley Cup-clinching goal before disappearing four months later) and Feb. 10, 1942 (when the Bruins' "Kraut Line" of **Bobby Bauer**, **Woody Dumart** and **Milt Schmidt** contested their final game before serving in the Royal Canadian Air Force).
- 1917 Year that the Seattle Metropolitans of the Pacific Coast Hockey Association (PCHA) became the first U.S. team to win the Stanley Cup. Their five contests against the Canadiens at Seattle Ice Arena in the ill-fated 1919 Final marked the first playoff games by an NHL team in the U.S.
- Hits by Mariners star Ichiro Suzuki in 2004, a single-season MLB record previously set in 1920 by George Sisler (257). Sisler later was an MLB teammate of Jim Riley, who is believed to be the only individual to play in both the NHL and MLB. Riley skated eight seasons with the Metropolitans in the PCHA (while playing baseball in the summer) before signing with the Black Hawks in 1927, with whom he played three games before being traded to the Detroit Cougars.
- Outdoor games in League history, including the 2024 Discover NHL Winter Classic. The total is set to reach 41 with the 2024 Navy Federal Credit Union NHL Stadium Series at MetLife Stadium (Feb. 17-18).
- Edition of WrestleMania held at T-Mobile Park on March 30, 2003, with one of the highlights from the event being Chris Jericho facing his childhood idol, Shawn Michaels. Jericho's father, Ted Irvine, played parts of 11 seasons in the NHL and was inducted into the Manitoba Hockey Hall of Fame in the player category in 1985 34 years before Golden Knights general manager Kelly McCrimmon went in as a builder.
- Minutes of ice time logged by Golden Knights assistant coach Joel Ward with the Washington Capitals during their 3-2 victory in the 2015 Winter Classic at Nationals Park. Troy Brouwer scored the winner with 12.9 seconds remaining in regulation, which still stands as the latest go-ahead goal in an outdoor game.
- Years since Kraken general manager **Ron Francis** scored a goal with the Penguins during their 5-5 tie against the Capitals in the 2011 NHL Winter Classic Alumni Game at Heinz Field on Dec. 31, 2010.
- Years since Washington earned a 3-1 victory versus Pittsburgh in the 2011 Winter Classic at Heinz Field.
 Golden Knights president of hockey operations and alternate governor George McPhee was the Capitals' general manager at the time.
- Outdoor games played in baseball parks, including the 2024 Discover NHL Winter Classic. The 26 others have taken place in football venues (23 GP), atop a golf course (2 GP) and at a soccer stadium (1 GP).
- 12 Years since Kraken assistant coach **Dave Lowry** was behind the Calgary Flames' bench in the same capacity during Calgary's 4-0 win against Montreal in the 2011 Heritage Classic at McMahon Stadium.
- Years since Golden Knights defenseman **Brayden McNabb** captained the WHL's Kootenay Ice to an Ed Chynoweth Cup as league champions in 2010-11. He played in more than 80 games with the Ice that season, including their 11-2 loss against the Spokane Chiefs in the Rockstar Outdoor Hockey Classic at Avista Stadium in Spokane on Jan. 15, 2011. That contest marked the first regular-season outdoor game in CHL history.

- Outdoor games that Kraken assistant general manager **Jason Botterill** has been involved in, including the 2024 Discover NHL Winter Classic. He was an executive with the Penguins for the 2008 Winter Classic at Ralph Wilson Stadium, 2011 Winter Classic at Heinz Field, 2014 Stadium Series at Soldier Field and 2017 Stadium Series at Heinz Field, and served as general manager of the Sabres for the 2018 Winter Classic at Citi Field. Vegas forward **Jack Eichel** made his outdoor game debut in Buffalo's overtime loss in 2018.
- Notable current NHL players with ties to Japan, including Kraken forward Kailer Yamamoto and Canadiens captain Nick Suzuki, who was selected by the Golden Knights with No. 13 pick in the 2017 NHL Draft (also Akito Hirose, Kiefer Sherwood and Jordan Spence). Ichiro Suzuki made his MLB debut with the Mariners at T-Mobile Park on April 2, 2001, and became the first Japanese-born position player in league history. Yutaka Fukufuji was the first Japanese-born player to dress in at least one regular-season or playoff NHL game.
- Outdoor games that Golden Knights assistant coach John Stevens has been involved in, including the 2024 Discover NHL Winter Classic. He was an assistant coach with the Kings for the 2014 Stadium Series at Dodger Stadium as well as the 2015 Stadium Series at Levi's Stadium, and served in the same capacity with the Dallas Stars for the 2020 Winter Classic at Cotton Bowl Stadium.

WASHINGTON STATE AND THE NHL

- * A total of 13 players born in Washington state have dressed at least one NHL game (regular season or playoffs), including Kraken forward **Kailer Yamamoto** as well as Stanley Cup winners **Wayne Hicks**, **Tyler Johnson** and **T.J. Oshie**. Yamamoto and his brother, **Keanu**, were taught how to skate by Johnson's mother, **Debbie**.
- * Minnesota Wild assistant coach **Patrick Dwyer**, who was selected by the Atlanta Thrashers with the No. 116 pick in the 2002 NHL Draft and skated parts of seven seasons in the League from 2008-09 to 2014-15, was born in Spokane and raised in Great Falls, Mont. Penguins assistant coach **Ty Hennes** lived in Kent during his youth but was born in Dickinson, N.D.
- * Washington will become the 16th U.S. state to host at least one outdoor game, while New Jersey is set to become the 17th when the 2024 Navy Federal Credit Union NHL Stadium Series takes place at MetLife Stadium from Feb. 17-18. Washington, D.C., and five Canadian provinces also have staged outdoor games.
- * T-Mobile Park will become the fifth Washington state venue to host a game involving the Kraken. Seattle contested three neutral-site preseason games in "The Evergreen State" ahead of its inaugural season while renovations at Climate Pledge Arena were being completed these took place at Spokane Veterans Memorial Arena in Spokane on Sept. 26, 2021, Angel of the Winds Arena in Everett on Oct. 1, 2021, and Accesso ShowWare Center in Kent on Oct. 2, 2021.
- * Hockey participation in Washington state nearly has doubled since the Kraken's inaugural campaign, going from 6,793 players in 2020-21 (the final season before Seattle's debut) to 11,876 in 2022-23. That includes a jump from 943 to 1,936 among female participants.

PRE-KRAKEN SEATTLE HOCKEY HISTORY

* The history of pro hockey in Seattle dates back more than 100 years before the Kraken contested their inaugural season, while major junior teams have been based in "Emerald City" since as early as 1977.

- * The Metropolitans contested nine seasons in the PCHA from 1915-16 to 1923-24, which included becoming the first U.S.-based team to win the Stanley Cup in 1917 as well as competing in the 1919 and 1920 Finals. Hockey Hall of Famers **Frank Foyston**, **Hap Holmes**, **Lester Patrick**, **Doc Roberts** and **Jack Walker** were some of the notable players to dress for the Metropolitans, who folded following the closure of Seattle Ice Arena in 1924.
- * Seattle-based pro teams competed in each iteration of the Pacific Coast Hockey League (PCHL) after construction of the Civic Ice Arena was completed in 1927.
- * The final iteration of the PCHL became the Western Hockey League in 1952 (not to be confused with the current major junior loop of the same name), and the pro circuit included Seattle-based teams. U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame inductees **Billy** and **Roger Christian** brothers who won gold at the 1960 Winter Olympics where several games were played outdoors played pro in Seattle. Billy's son, **Dave Christian**, appeared in the "Miracle on Ice" and played 15 NHL seasons.
- * Seattle won the Lester Patrick Cup as Western Hockey League champions three times (1968, 1967 and 1959) and contested several exhibition games against NHL teams before joining the Central Hockey League for their final season in 1974-75.
- * The Kamloops Chiefs became the Seattle Breakers in 1977, marking the city's first major junior team. The Breakers contested one season in the Western Canada Hockey League (WCHL) before it became the WHL and were renamed the Seattle Thunderbirds in 1985. The Thunderbirds captured their second Ed Chynoweth Cup as league champions in 2023 (also 2017) and made their third Memorial Cup appearance (also 2017 and 1992), falling to the **Patrick Roy**-led Quebec Remparts in the final.
- * Other WHL teams based around Seattle include the Everett Silvertips (2003-04 Present) and Tacoma Rockets (1991-92 1994-95). Notable players who dressed for major junior clubs based in the Seattle metropolitan area include Golden Knights teammates **Keegan Kolesar** and **Shea Theodore**; fellow Stanley Cup winners **Glenn Anderson**, **Ken Daneyko** and **Chris Osgood**; Calder Memorial Trophy recipient **Mathew Barzal**; and the NHL's all-time games played leader **Patrick Marleau**.

BUILDING AN ICE RINK FOR AN OUTDOOR NHL GAME

Constructing an NHL-caliber ice rink outdoors at a facility designed for a sport other than hockey is a unique challenge. Much more than taking a garden hose into your backyard and flooding an area, for its outdoor games, the National Hockey League uses special equipment, expertise and technology to create an ice rink fit for the best hockey players in the world.

The most important aspects of making outdoor ice for an NHL game are ensuring the conditions meet all of the safety standards required for the players and providing all of the tools necessary for an NHL game. To accommodate its outdoor games, the NHL designed and built a one-of-a-kind mobile refrigeration unit and rink system.

The main function of the 53-foot, 300-ton capacity refrigeration unit is to perform the key function of making a great sheet of ice – to remove heat from the surface and stabilize the temperature.

To do this, the unit pumps as much as 3,000 gallons of glycol coolant into custom-made aluminum trays that are configured on the field of the stadium. Running through a series of hoses from the refrigeration unit to the field, the glycol chills the trays in order to keep the ice near its ideal surface temperature of 22°F/6°C. Following the placement of the ice trays, the rink boards are installed.

Once the boards are up and the ideal surface temperature is attained, the actual process of building the ice begins. In an NHL arena, the ice is built to a thickness of approximately 1-1.25 inches. An outdoor rink, however, requires up to 2 inches of ice thickness to help withstand the more extreme elements. While many speculate that it takes special water to create the ice, the water used is the same tap water provided into everyone's homes.



Water is added as slowly as possible, in as fine a mist as the process will allow. Workers pass the spray wand over the ice rink hundreds of times, providing a more-even freeze and better-quality playing surface. Each inch of ice thickness requires approximately 10,000 gallons of water. For finishing touches, the ice surface is whitened using approximately 350 gallons of water-soluble paint. The lines and logos then are painted and placed on the surface, with more ice built on top.

Once constructed, monitoring the status of the ice is a 24-hour job. To help this process, a high-tech system called "Eye on the Ice" is embedded in the surface. The technology provides updates on temperatures at different areas of the ice, signaling an alert prompting the need to pump more glycol or engage the in-line heating system in case the weather gets too cold.
