



2021 DRAFT PROSPECTS: NHL TIES AND BLOODLINES

McTavish, Mason
No. 2-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Dale**, played nine games for the Flames in the 1996-97 season (1-2—3 in 9 GP) and played 14 seasons of professional hockey overseas with stops in Finland and Switzerland.

Raty, Aatu
No. 3-ranked ITL Skater

His brother, **Aku**, was a fifth-round pick by the Coyotes in the 2019 NHL Draft (151st overall) who skated for Karpat in the Finnish Elite League in 2020-21 (4-3—7 in 36 GP).

Hughes, Luke
No. 4-ranked N.A. Skater

Has two brothers who were recent first-round picks in the NHL Draft: **Quinn** (No. 7 in 2018 w/ VAN) and **Jack** (No. 1 in 2019 w/ NJD). His mother, **Ellen**, played soccer, lacrosse and ice hockey at the University of New Hampshire and is a former member of the U.S. Women's National Hockey Team. His father, **Jim**, was a member of the U.S. Selects team that won the 1988 Spengler Cup and has held a number of coaching and player development positions in the NCAA, IHL, AHL and NHL.

Lindbom, Carl
No. 5-ranked ITL Goaltender

His brother, **Olof**, is also a goaltender who was a second-round pick by the Rangers in 2018 (39th overall) and played for Mora in Sweden's second division in 2020-21.

Clarke, Brandt
No. 7-ranked N.A. Skater

His brother, **Graeme**, is a forward who was a third-round pick by the Devils in the 2019 NHL Draft (80th overall) and spent the majority of the 2020-21 season with the AHL's Binghamton Devils (8-10—18 in 31 GP).

Korhonen, Rasmus
No. 7-ranked ITL Goaltender

His father, **Markus**, is a former Blackhawks scout who tended goal for over a decade in professional leagues across Europe and is the current goaltending coach for Ilves in Finland's top professional league.

Serhyenko, Carter
No. 9-ranked N.A. Goaltender

His cousin, **Ryan Bayda**, was a third-round pick by the Hurricanes in 2000 (80th overall) and appeared in 179 career NHL games with Carolina from 2002-03 to 2008-09 (16-24—40 in 179 GP).





Sillinger, Cole
No. 10-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Mike**, was a forward who skated in 1,049 career regular-season games spanning 17 NHL seasons with a dozen different teams (240-308—548 in 1,049 GP). He is the only player in NHL history to play for 12 or more different franchises.

Malik, Nick
No. 10-ranked ITL Goaltender

His father, **Marek**, was a defenseman who was a third-round pick of the Hartford Whalers in 1993 (72nd overall) and skated in 691 career NHL regular-season games with the Whalers, Hurricanes, Canucks, Rangers and Lightning (33-135—168 in 691 GP).

Robertsson, Simon
No. 11-ranked ITL Skater

His father, **Bert**, was a 10th-round pick by the Canucks in the 1993 NHL Draft (254th overall) who skated in 123 career NHL regular-season games with the Canucks, Oilers and Rangers from 1997-98 to 2000-01.

Salminen, Samu
No. 12-ranked ITL Skater

His brother, **Saku**, was a seventh-round pick by the Lightning in the 2013 NHL Draft (184th overall) who played seven seasons of professional hockey in Finland, Germany, Sweden and France.

Helenius, Samuel
No. 15-ranked ITL Skater

His father, **Sami**, was a fifth-round pick by the Flames in 1992 (102nd overall) who appeared in 155 career NHL regular-season games with the Flames, Lightning, Avalanche, Stars and Blackhawks from 1996-97 to 2002-03.

Dach, Colton
No. 19-ranked N.A. Skater

His brother, **Kirby**, was a first-round selection by the Blackhawks in 2019 (No. 3 overall) and recorded 2-8—10 in 18 games with Chicago in 2020-21.

Kapanen, Oliver
No. 22-ranked ITL Skater

His uncle, **Sami**, was a fourth-round pick by the Whalers in 1995 who recorded 189-269—458 in 831 career NHL regular-season games with the Whalers, Hurricanes and Flyers. His cousin, **Kasper**, was a first-round pick by the Penguins in 2014 and recorded 11-19—30 in 40 regular-season games with Pittsburgh in 2020-21.

Boucher, Tyler
No. 25-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Brian**, is a former goaltender and current NHL analyst who competed for 13 seasons with the Flyers, Coyotes, Flames, Blackhawks, Blue Jackets, Sharks and Hurricanes. He set a modern-day NHL record by [posting five consecutive shutouts](#) for Phoenix from Dec. 31, 2003 to Jan. 9, 2004.





Richard, Guillaume
No. 32-ranked N.A. Skater

His uncle, **Jean-Marc**, appeared in five games with the Quebec Nordiques from 1987-88 to 1989-90 (2-1—3 in 5 GP) and had a lengthy professional career including stops in the AHL, IHL and Germany.

Korczak, Ryder
No. 34-ranked N.A. Skater

His brother, **Kaedan**, was a second-round pick by the Golden Knights in 2019 (41st overall) and helped Team Canada earn a silver medal at the 2021 World Junior Championship.

Stillman, Chase
No. 35-ranked N.A. Skater

His brother, **Riley**, was a fourth-round pick by the Panthers in 2016 (114th overall) who currently plays for the Blackhawks. His father, **Cory**, was a first-round pick by the Flames in 1992 (No. 6 overall) who went on to record 278-449—727 in 1,025 career regular-season games with the Flames, Blues, Lightning, Hurricanes, Senators and Panthers. Cory is a two-time Stanley Cup champion (2004 w/ TBL and 2006 w/ CAR). His grandfather, **Bud Stefanski**, was a ninth-round selection by the Rangers in 1975 (154th overall) who also played in the IHL, AHL, CHL and Austria.

Morrow, Scott
No. 39-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Steve**, was a 10th-round pick by the Flyers in 1987 (209th overall) who played for the AHL's Hershey Bears and CHL's Fort Worth Fire. His uncle, **Scott**, was a fifth-round pick by the Hartford Whalers in 1988 (95th overall) and appeared in four games with the Flames in 1994-95.

Allan, Nolan
No. 40-ranked N.A. Skater

His uncle, **Chad**, was a third-round pick by the Canucks in 1994 (65th overall) who played 11 seasons of professional hockey in the AHL, Germany and Austria and helped Team Canada earn a gold medal at the 1996 World Junior Championship. His uncle, **Karl Taylor**, served as head coach of the AHL's Milwaukee Admirals from 2018-19 to 2019-20.

Bar, Jack
No. 41-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Mark**, was a fourth-round pick by the Flyers in 1986 (83rd overall).

Robidas, Justin
No. 47-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Stephane**, was a seventh-round pick by the Canadiens in 1995 (164th overall) and appeared in 937 career regular-season games with the Canadiens, Stars, Blackhawks, Ducks and Maple Leafs.



Huckins, Cole
No. 48-ranked N.A. Skater

His uncle, **Jim Malone**, was a first-round pick by the Rangers in the 1980 NHL Draft (14th overall) and his uncle, **Greg Malone**, was a second-round pick by the Penguins in 1976 (19th overall) who appeared in 704 regular-season games with the Penguins, Whalers and Nordiques. His cousin, **Ryan Malone**, was a fourth-round pick by the Penguins in 1999 (115th overall) who skated in 647 regular-season games with the Penguins, Lightning and Rangers while his other cousin, **Brad Malone**, was a fourth-round pick by the Avalanche in 2007 (105th overall) who has appeared in 199 regular-season games with the Avalanche, Hurricanes and Oilers and in 2020-21 served as captain of the AHL's Bakersfield Condors.

Blake, Jackson
No. 52-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Jason**, was an undrafted forward who played in 871 career regular-season games with the Kings, Islanders, Maple Leafs and Ducks and was the recipient of the 2007-08 Bill Masterton Memorial Trophy after battling a leukemia diagnosis without missing a single game.

Savage, Redmond
No. 54-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Brian**, was an eighth-round pick by the Canadiens in 1991 (171st overall) who skated in 674 career regular-season games with the Canadiens, Coyotes, Blues and Flyers.

Chiasson, Jake
No. 61-ranked N.A. Skater

His uncle, **Doug Lidster**, was a seventh-round pick by the Canucks in 1980 (133rd overall) who appeared in 897 career regular-season games with the Canucks, Rangers, Blues and Stars.

Spacek, David
No. 79-ranked ITL Skater

His father, **Jaroslav**, was a defenseman selected by the Panthers in the third round of the 1998 NHL Draft who went on to skate in 880 career NHL regular-season games with the Panthers, Blackhawks, Blue Jackets, Oilers, Sabres, Canadiens and Hurricanes.

Doan, Josh
No. 87-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Shane**, was a first-round pick by the original Jets in 1995 (No. 7 overall) and spent his entire 21-season career with Jets/Coyotes franchise (402-570-972 in 1,540 GP) where he served as captain from 2003-04 to 2016-17. His grandfather, **Bernie**, was a sixth-round pick by the Blues in 1971 (80th overall).

Plandowski, Oscar
No. 94-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Darryl**, is the Director of Amateur Scouting for the Coyotes.



Eljas, Arvid
No. 94-ranked ITL Skater

His second-cousin, **Emil Heineman**, was a second-round pick by the Flames in 2020 (43rd overall) who skated for Leksands of the Swedish Hockey League in 2020-21.

Fusco, Matthew
No. 97-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Mark**, appeared in 80 career regular-season games with the Whalers from 1983-84 to 1984-85 (3-12—15 in 80 GP) and represented Team USA at the 1984 Winter Olympic Games. His uncle, **Scott**, was an 11th-round pick by the Devils in 1982 (211th overall) who twice represented Team USA at the Winter Olympics (1984 and 1988).

Mittelstadt, Luke
No. 98-ranked N.A. Skater

His brother, **Casey**, was a first-round pick by the Sabres in 2017 (No. 8 overall) who posted 10-12—22 in 41 regular-season games with Buffalo in 2020-21.

Mechura, Adam
No. 99-ranked ITL Skater

His uncle, **Pavel Kasparik**, was a seventh-round pick by the Flyers in 1999 (200th overall) who played his entire professional career in the Czech Republic where he was a four-time Czech Extraliga champion.

Kressler, Braeden
No. 103-ranked N.A. Skater

His cousin, **Kyle Quincey**, was a fourth-round pick by the Red Wings in 2003 (132nd overall) and has appeared in 586 regular-season games with the Red Wings, Kings, Avalanche, Devils, Blue Jackets and Wild.

Landry, Manix
No. 108-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Eric**, played in 68 career NHL games with the Flames and Canadiens from 1997-98 to 2001-02 (5-9—14 in 68 GP), followed by nine seasons in Europe with stops in Switzerland and Russia.

Lachance, Shane
No. 110-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Scott**, was a first-round pick by the Islanders in 1991 (No. 4 overall) and skated in 819 regular-season games with the Islanders, Canadiens, Canucks and Blue Jackets. He also represented the Islanders at the 1997 NHL All-Star Game.

Tammela, Jeremi
No. 112-ranked ITL Skater

His brother, **Jonne**, was a fourth-round pick by the Lightning in 2015 (118th overall) who won a championship with Lukko of the Finnish Elite League in 2020-21.

Gasseau, Andre
No. 116-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **James**, was a sixth-round pick by the Sabres in 1984 (123rd overall) who played for the AHL's Rochester Americans from 1986-87 to 1987-88.





Arcuri, Francesco
No. 122-ranked N.A. Skater

His cousin, **Mike Cammalleri**, was a second-round pick by the Kings in 2001 (49th overall) who recorded 294-348—642 in 906 career regular-season games with the Kings, Flames, Canadiens, Devils and Oilers.

St. Louis, Ryan
No. 125-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Martin**, is a Hockey Hall of Fame forward who recorded 391-642—1,033 in 1,134 regular-season games. Among his many accolades, St. Louis won the Stanley Cup in 2004 (w/ TBL), the Art Ross Trophy twice (2003-04 and 2012-13) and the Hart Trophy (2003-04).

Janicke, Justin
No. 128-ranked N.A. Skater

His brother, **Trevor**, was a fifth-round pick by the Ducks in 2019 (132nd overall) who skated for the University of Notre Dame in 2020-21.

Burroughs, Ethan
No. 138-ranked N.A. Skater

His grandfather is former NHL referee **Tom Smith**.

McCleary, Ryan
No. 141-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Trent**, appeared in 192 career regular-season games with the Senators, Bruins and Canadiens from 1995-96 to 1999-2000.

Krebs, Dru
No. 142-ranked N.A. Skater

His brother, **Peyton**, was a first-round pick by the Golden Knights in the 2019 NHL Draft (17th overall) who led all WHL players in points with 13-30—43 in 24 GP in 2020-21. He also appeared in four NHL games for Vegas in the 2020-21 campaign.

Sirizzotti, Brenden
No. 143-ranked N.A. Skater

His cousin, **Andrew Crescenzi**, appeared in two games for the Kings in 2017-18 and played for seven seasons in the AHL where he won the Calder Cup championship in 2014-15 as a member of the Manchester Monarchs.

Ertel, Justin
No. 150-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Tyler**, was an 11th-round pick by the Canucks in the 1990 NHL Draft (212th overall).

Brown, Caden
No. 152-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Jeff**, was a second-round pick by the Nordiques in the 1984 NHL Draft (36th overall) and ranks 44th on the NHL's all-time list for points by a defenseman with 154-430—584 in 747 career regular-season games. His brother, **Logan**, was a first-round pick by the Senators in 2016 who has appeared in 30 NHL games with Ottawa since 2017-18.





Cardwell, Ethan
No. 159-ranked N.A. Skater

His grandfather, **Steve**, was a fifth-round pick by the Penguins in 1970 (63rd overall) who appeared in 53 games for the Penguins from 1970-71 to 1972-73 (9-11—20 in 54 GP).

Maggio, Matthew
No. 175-ranked N.A. Skater

His cousin, **Dan**, was a sixth-round pick by the Rangers in 2009 (170th overall) who had an eight-season professional career with stops in the ECHL, AHL, CHL and Denmark.

Hache, Braden
No. 181-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Conrad**, is a former NHL referee and the current OHL Director of Officiating.

Delay, Tim
No. 187-ranked N.A. Skater

His uncle, **Mike**, was a ninth-round pick by the Maple Leafs in 1988 (174th overall)

Ginnell, Riley
No. 191-ranked N.A. Skater

His grandfather, **Pat**, was a longtime scout in the Blues organization. His father, **Erin**, was a fourth-round pick by the Capitals in 1986 (82nd overall) and currently serves as an amateur scout in the Golden Knights organization. His uncle, **Dan**, is an amateur scout for the Blues. His uncle, Kevin, was a fifth-round pick by the Blackhawks in 1980 (99th overall).

Saganiuk, Colby
No. 193-ranked N.A. Skater

His grandfather, **Rocky**, was a second-round pick by the Maple Leafs in 1977 (29th overall) who recorded 57-65—122 in 259 career regular-season games with the Maple Leafs and Penguins.

Avon, Jon-Randall
No. 200-ranked N.A. Skater

His stepfather, **Steve Larmer**, was a sixth-round pick by the Blackhawks in 1980 (120th overall) who recorded 441-571—1,012 in 1,006 career regular season games with the Blackhawks and Rangers. Larmer won the Calder Trophy in 1982-83 (w/ CHI) and the Stanley Cup in 1994 (w/ NYR).

McGroarty, Matthew
No. 205-ranked N.A. Skater

His cousin, **Alex DeBrincat**, was a second-round pick by the Blackhawks in 2016 (39th overall) who recorded 32-24—56 in 52 games with Chicago in 2020-21.

Serdachny, Noah
No. 208-ranked N.A. Skater

His father, **Steve**, is a skating and skills instructor who has worked with multiple NHL players and for the Oilers organization.





Murray, Owen
No. 210-ranked N.A. Skater

His great uncle, **Dallas Smith**, is a two-time Stanley Cup champion (1970 and 1972 w/ BOS) who appeared in 889 career regular-season games with the Bruins and Rangers (55-252—307 in 889 GP).
