## MILESTONE WATCH: NOTABLE PLAYERS IN 2024-25 REGULAR SEASON

### **Alex Ovechkin**

- \* 895 Goals: Ovechkin is 42 goals shy of surpassing Wayne Gretzky (894) for the most in NHL history.
- \* 20-Goal Season: Ovechkin's next 20-goal season will tie him for the second most in NHL history.

## **Andrei Vasilevskiy**

\* 300 Wins: Vasilevskiy can become the fastest goaltender in NHL history to record 300 wins.

#### **Auston Matthews**

- \* 400 Goals: Matthews can require the fewest games by an active player to score 400 goals and fifth fewest in NHL history.
- \* 60-Goal Seasons: Matthews can become the sixth player in NHL history with three 60-goal seasons.

#### **Brent Burns**

\* Consecutive Games Played: Burns can move as high as fourth place on the all-time list for most consecutive games played in NHL history.

## **Connor Hellebuyck**

\* 300 Wins: Hellebuyck can become the fastest U.S.-born goaltender in NHL history to 300 wins.

## **Connor McDavid**

- \* 1,000 Points: McDavid can require the fewest games by an active player to record 1,000 points and the third fewest in NHL history.
- \* 700 Assists: McDavid can require the fewest games by an active player to record 700 assists and the third fewest in NHL history.
- \* 100-Point Seasons: McDavid can become the fourth player in NHL history with at least eight 100-point seasons.

### **Leon Draisaitl**

\* 900 Points: Draisaitl can be among the five fastest active players to reach 900 points. He also can be among the 10 fastest in NHL history among players born outside North America.

## Sergei Bobrovsky

\* 400 Wins: Bobrovsky can become the fastest goaltender in NHL history to 400 wins.

# **Sidney Crosby**

\* 1,600 Points: Crosby needs four points to become the 10th player in NHL history to reach the milestone.

#### Seasons and Games

## Most Consecutive Games Played, NHL History

\* Brent Burns (CAR; 843 GP) owns the seventh longest streak in League history and can climb as high as fourth on the all-time list.

#### Most Seasons Played, Career

- \* Brent Burns is set to appear in his 21st season the most among all active players.
- \* Five players are expected to skate in their 20th season: Sidney Crosby (PIT), Alex Ovechkin (WSH), Zach Parise (UFA), Corey Perry (EDM) and Ryan Suter (STL).

## Goals

## Most Goals, Career

- \* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 853) needs 42 goals to overtake Wayne Gretzky (894) for the most in NHL history.
- \* **Sidney Crosby** (PIT; 592) needs 10 goals to surpass Jari Kurri (601) for sole possession of 20th place in NHL history. A 34-goal season would propel Crosby ahead of five players into 16th place all time.
- \* **Steven Stamkos** (NSH; 555) will tie Johnny Bucyk (556) for 29th place in NHL history with his first goal for Nashville. He is 10 goals from sole possession of 25th place all time and within striking distance of the top 20.
- \* Patrick Kane (DET; 471) needs 20 goals to enter the top 50 in NHL history he would tie Jean Ratelle (491).

## Most Goals, Career, Including Playoffs

\* Sidney Crosby (PIT; 663) needs 37 goals to become the 17th player in NHL history with 700.

## Most Goals, Defenseman, Career

\* **Brent Burns** (CAR; 255) needs 10 goals to overtake Nicklas Lidstrom (264) for eighth place among defensemen in NHL history and 16 to surpass Bobby Orr (270) for seventh.

## **Assists**

## Most Assists, Career

- \* Sidney Crosby (PIT; 1,004) needs 13 assists to leapfrog Joe Sakic (1,016) for sole possession of 13th place in NHL history. A 46-assist season would put Crosby alone in 10th place all-time, overtaking Sakic, Mario Lemieux (1,033), Marcel Dionne (1,040) and Gordie Howe (1,049).
- \* **Patrick Kane** (DET; 813) needs one assist to surpass Mike Modano (813) for sole possession of the second most among American-born skaters in NHL history, behind only Phil Housley (894). Kane, **Evgeni Malkin** (PIT; 798) and **Anze Kopitar** (LAK; 792) all rank among the top 40 in NHL history with room to climb in 2024-25.

## **Points**

## Most Points, Career

- \* **Sidney Crosby** (PIT; 1,596) is 46 points from passing Joe Sakic (1,641) for ninth place in NHL history. Mario Lemieux (1,723) would be next for Crosby to surpass.
- \* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 1,550), who ranks second in points among active players, needs 30 points to surpass Ray Bourque (1,579) for sole possession of 12th place in NHL history and 41 to overtake Phil Esposito (1,590) for 11th position.

Most Points, Career, Including Playoffs



\* Sidney Crosby (PIT; 10th w/ 1,797) and Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 14th w/ 1,691) are within reach of leapfrogging multiple Hall of Fame players and climbing the all-time list. Crosby needs three points to become the 10th player in NHL history with 1,800 points, including playoffs.

## Most Points, Defensemen, Career

- \* **Brent Burns** (CAR; 881) needs 16 points to overtake Brad Park (896) for sole possession of 13th place in NHL history among defensemen and 19 to become the 13th blueliner to reach the 900-point milestone.
- \* **Erik Karlsson** (PIT; 817), who ranks second in points among active defensemen, needs 11 points to surpass Doug Wilson (827) for sole possession of 16th place in NHL history and 28 to overtake Gary Suter (844) for 15th.
- \* Kris Letang (PIT; 25th) and Victor Hedman (TBL; 27th) both can hit 800 points and climb the all-time list among defensemen, while four blueliners are nearing the 700-point milestone: Roman Josi (NSH; 686), Ryan Suter (STL; 681), John Carlson (WSH; 674) and Drew Doughty (LAK; 669).

# Special Teams (Since 1933-34)

Most Power-Play Goals, Career

- \* All-time NHL leader Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 312) is the only player on record with 300 power-play goals.
- \* Steven Stamkos (NSH; 214) needs one power-play goal to tie Joe Nieuwendyk (215) for 13th place on the all-time list and three to match Jaromir Jagr (217) and Mike Gartner (217) for 11th place. Stamkos needs 18 to tie Dino Ciccarelli (232), which would break him into the top 10.

## Most Shorthanded Goals, Career

\* **Brad Marchand** (BOS; 36) needs one shorthanded goal to break a tie with Sergei Fedorov (36) for sole possession of eighth place on record. Marchand needs three to match Dave Poulin, Butch Goring and Jari Kurri (all w/ 39) for fifth place all time and four to become the fifth player on record with 40 shorthanded goals.

## Scoring Plateaus

## Most 20-Goal Seasons, Career

- \* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 19) can break a tie with Brendan Shanahan, Dave Andreychuk and Jaromir Jagr (all w/ 19) and tie Ron Francis (20) for the second most in NHL history behind Gordie Howe (22).
- \* Patrick Kane (DET; 16) and Sidney Crosby (PIT; 16) are tied for second among active players in terms of 20-goal seasons, ahead of Evgeni Malkin (PIT; 15). Only 15 players in League history have had 17 or more.

# Most 20-Goal Seasons, Consecutive

\* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 19) can break a tie with Brendan Shanahan and join Gordie Howe (22) as the second player in NHL history to record 20-plus goals in at least 20 consecutive NHL seasons played.

# Most 30-Goal Seasons, Career

\* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 18) already holds the NHL record. Sidney Crosby (PIT; 12) can become the 11th player in League history with at least 13.

# Most 30-Goal Seasons, Consecutive

\* Auston Matthews (TOR; 8) and Connor McDavid (EDM; 8) can each record their ninth consecutive – a feat achieved by only 16 players in NHL history, including only Alex Ovechkin (15 from 2005-06 to 2019-20) among active players.

## Most 40-Goal Seasons, Career

\* **Steven Stamkos** (NSH; 7) can record his eighth 40-goal season, a feat accomplished by 10 players in NHL history (**Alex Ovechkin**, 13, is the all-time leader and only active player to achieve the feat).

## Most 40-Goal Seasons, Consecutive



\* Auston Matthews (TOR; 5) can become the 14th player in NHL history with six consecutive 40-goal seasons – a feat achieved by only one player in the past 30 years (Ilya Kovalchuk: 6 from 2003-04 to 2009-10). Matthews and Alex Ovechkin (5 from 2005-06 – 2009-10) are the only active players with five in a row.

# Most 50-Goal Seasons, Career

- \* **Alex Ovechkin** (WSH; 9) is tied with Mike Bossy and Wayne Gretzky for the most 50-goal seasons in NHL history.
- \* **Leon Draisait!** (EDM; 3) can become the 15th player in NHL history to record four 50-goal seasons and the second active to do so alongside **Alex Ovechkin** (9).

## Most 60-Goal Seasons, Career

\* **Auston Matthews** (TOR; 2) can become the sixth player in NHL history with three such campaigns. Only eight different players have had consecutive 60-goal seasons.

## Most 100-Point Seasons, Career

\* **Connor McDavid** (EDM; 7) can become the fourth player in NHL history with at least eight 100-point seasons, following Wayne Gretzky (15), Mario Lemieux (10) and Marcel Dionne (8).

## Most 100-Point Seasons, Consecutive

- \* **Connor McDavid** (EDM; 4) can become the 13th player in NHL history with five consecutive 100-point campaigns and the first to do so in more than 30 years Steve Yzerman was the last to achieve the feat (6; 1987-88 1992-93).
- \* Leon DraisaitI (EDM: 3), Mikko Rantanen (COL; 2), Nikita Kucherov (TBL; 2), David Pastrnak (BOS; 2) and Nathan MacKinnon (COL; 2) also enter 2024-25 with an active streak of at least two straight 100-point seasons.

## Hat Tricks

## Most Hat Tricks, Career

- \* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 30) needs three hat tricks to surpass Phil Esposito (5th; 32) and tie Brett Hull (33) for fourth place in NHL history.
- \* **David Pastrnak** (BOS; 17), who ranks second among active players, enters 2024-25 tied for 28th place in NHL history and needs two to break into the top 20.

## Game-Winning Goals

## Most Game-Winning Goals, Career

\* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 129) trails only Jaromir Jagr (135) for the most game-winning goals in NHL history.

## Most Game-Winning Goals, Career, Including Playoffs

- \* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 139) owns the second most in NHL history, trailing only Jaromir Jagr (151).
- \* Sidney Crosby (PIT; 99), Evgeni Malkin (PIT; 96), Brad Marchand (BOS; 90) and Steven Stamkos (NSH; 90) are all within 10 of 100 such tallies a list that includes only 24 players ahead of 2024-25.

## Most Game-Winning Goals, Defenseman, Career

- \* **Brent Burns** (CAR; 42) needs two game-winning goals to surpass Paul Coffey (5th; 43) and tie Denis Potvin and Al MacInnis (both w/ 44) for third place in NHL history among defensemen.
- \* **Erik Karlsson** (PIT; t-10th w/ 37) and **Oliver Ekman-Larsson** (TOR; t-14th w/ 35) also rank among the top 15 in NHL history in terms of game-winning goals by defensemen, with room to climb and with many other active blueliners close behind them.

### Multi-Goal Games

\* Alex Ovechkin (WSH; 173) ranks second in NHL history for multi-goal games, behind Wayne Gretzky (189). Sidney Crosby (PIT; 101) and Steven Stamkos (NSH; 97) also rank among the top 30, with room to climb in 2024-25.

## Multi-Assist Games

\* **Sidney Crosby** (PIT; 242) needs 14 multi-assist games to surpass Ray Bourque (9th; 255) and tie Marcel Dionne (256) for eighth place in NHL history.

#### Multi-Point Games

\* **Sidney Crosby** (PIT; 470) needs one multi-point game to break a tie with Ron Francis (470) for sole possession of ninth place in NHL history. He needs four such performances to overtake Joe Sakic (473) into eighth place and eight to leapfrog Steve Yzerman (477) for seventh place – Mario Lemieux (6th; 497) would be his next target.

## Seasons and Games

## Most Games Played, Career

- \* Marc-Andre Fleury (MIN; 1,025 GP) needs five games to leapfrog Patrick Roy (1,029 GP) for the third place in NHL history among goaltenders and 20 to overtake Roberto Luongo (1,044) for second place behind Martin Brodeur (1,266).
- \* **Jonathan Quick** (NYR; 780 GP) needs 20 games to become the 17th goaltender to play in 800 career contests he would overtake five goaltenders on the all-time games played list on his way to that milestone.

### Wins

## Most Wins, Career

\* Marc-Andre Fleury (MIN; 561) is the leader among active goaltenders and ranks second in NHL history behind Martin Brodeur (691). Sergei Bobrovsky (FLA; 14th w/ 396) and Jonathan Quick (NYR; 15th w/ 393), who rank second and third, respectively, among active netminders, both can climb multiple spots on the all-time wins list.

## Shutouts

## Most Shutouts, Career

- \* Marc-Andre Fleury (MIN; 75) needs two shutouts to overtake Ed Belfour (76) and Tony Esposito (76), who share 10th place, and tie Roberto Luongo (77) for ninth place in NHL history.
- \* **Jonathan Quick** (NYR; 60) needs one shutout to break a tie with Pekka Rinne (60) and tie Turk Broda (61) for 18th place in NHL history. Former Rangers goaltender Henrik Lundqvist (17th; 64) would be his next target.

## Win Plateaus

# Most 30-Win Seasons, Career

\* Marc-Andre Fleury (MIN; 9) is tied with Ed Belfour for the fourth-most 30-win seasons in NHL history, behind Martin Brodeur (14), Patrick Roy (13) and Henrik Lundqvist (11). Sergei Bobrovsky (FLA; 7) and Andrei Vasilevskiy (TBL; 7) are part of a tie for ninth place; only eight goaltenders in NHL history have had at least eight 30-win campaigns.

## Most 30-Win Seasons, Consecutive

\* Andrei Vasilevskiy (TBL; 7) can become the third goaltender in NHL history with eight consecutive 30-win seasons – he would join Martin Brodeur (12) and Patrick Roy (8).



#### **HEAD COACHES**

## Seasons and Games

## Most Seasons, Career

\* **Paul Maurice** (FLA; 26) is set to tie Dick Irvin (27) for the second most seasons as an NHL head coach behind Scotty Bowman (30). **Lindy Ruff** (BUF; 23) will take sole possession of fifth place on that list, while **Peter Laviolette** (NYR; 22) and **John Tortorella** (PHI; 22) are set to climb into a tie for sixth place.

## Most Seasons, Single Franchise

- \* **Lindy Ruff** (BUF; 15) will return to Buffalo where he previously served as head coach from 1997-98 to 2012-13. His 16th season as head coach of the Sabres will place him into sole possession of fourth place in terms of seasons as head coach of one franchise.
- \* **Jon Cooper** (TBL; 12) will serve his 13th season as head coach of the Lightning to become the 11th head coach in NHL history with as many campaigns for one franchise.

## Most Games, Career

- \* **Paul Maurice** (FLA; 1,848) is 52 games from joining Scotty Bowman (2,141) as the only head coaches to serve in 1,900 regular-season games.
