

The 2024-25 season opens Oct. 4-5, 2024 in Prague, Czechia for the 2024 NHL Global Series before the puck drops in North America starting with a tripleheader on Oct. 8, when the St. Louis Blues visit the Seattle Kraken and the Florida Panthers will raise the franchise's first Stanley Cup championship banner prior to their game against the Boston Bruins. Utah Hockey Club's first-ever game concludes the evening when **Connor Bedard** and the Chicago Blackhawks travel to Delta Center.

REIGNING CHAMPIONS RETURN TO AMERANT BANK ARENA TO OPEN SEASON

The Panthers return home to Amerant Bank Arena for their 2024-25 season opener 107 days after they treated their home fans with a Game 7 victory against the Oilers to capture the first Stanley Cup championship in franchise history. Florida owns the NHL's best points percentage when competing in a <u>season-opening game on home ice</u> and have yet to suffer a regulation loss in those contests (10-0-2; .917).

* Defending Stanley Cup champions are 61-26-16 (103 GP) in season openers in NHL history, including a 5-3-2 mark in the past 10 seasons and an 8-7-5 clip over the past 20. (There was no Stanley Cup champion in 1918-19 due to the influenza epidemic. A non-NHL team won the Stanley Cup in 1924-25).

UTAH READY TO GET UP-AND-RUNNING FOR 2024-25

The NHL's newest franchise gets its inaugural season underway almost immediately when the puck drops for opening night in North America, as Utah Hockey Club clash with the Blackhawks for a mutual season-opening game on Oct. 8. Since 1967-68, franchises hold a record of 7-17-3 in their first-ever regular-season game; Vegas is the only franchise in the past 30 years to earn a season-opening victory in its inaugural campaign.

* **Clayton Keller**, fresh off consecutive 30-goal campaigns, begins his quest for a third straight when Delta Center hosts its first-ever NHL regular-season game. The 25-year-old forward has accumulated 3-4—7 in seven career season-opening contests – the most points in that scenario on Utah's active roster. His three goals are tied with **Nick Schmaltz** (3-2—5 in 8 GP) while newly-acquired **Mikhail Sergachev** (0-6—6 in 8 GP) owns the most assists.

GOALIES TO RECORD A SHUTOUT

None. The only goaltender in NHL history to record a shutout in his team's first-ever NHL game was **Hal Winkler**. Winkler, who backstopped the Rangers to a 1-0 victory at Madison Square Garden II, blanked the Montreal Maroons on <u>Nov. 16, 1926</u>.



TEAMS AND THEIR SEASON-OPENING #NHLSTATS IN 2024-25

* Toronto and Montreal will be meeting in a mutual season-opening game for the sixth time in seven seasons, with the Maple Leafs winning four of the previous five entering this campaign (TOR: 4-1-0; MTL: 1-1-3). The 2024-25 schedule marks the 22nd time the longtime rivals have been opponents in a mutual season-opening game – the highest such total in NHL history, ahead of the Canucks-Flames (12; VAN: 7-3-1, CGY: 3-7-1).

* Vancouver and Calgary are meeting in a mutual season-opening game for the first time since 2018-19, when the former skated to a 5-2 victory at Rogers Arena. The Canucks' seven victories against the Flames are the third most by one franchise versus another in a season-opening contest behind the Maple Leafs (13-7-1 vs. MTL) and Canadiens (8-10-3 vs. TOR).

* The Bruins, Hurricanes and Golden Knights enter 2024-25 having each won their past five season-opening games, tied for the longest active streak among all teams. Each one of those clubs can join the Lightning (7 from 2014-15 – 2020-21), Sharks (7 from 2010-11 – 2016-17) and Red Wings (6 from 1999-00 – 2005-06) as the only teams in the past 20 years to win at least six straight season openers.

* The Flyers own the NHL's longest active *point* streak in season-opening contests (9 GP; 7-0-2 since 2015-16) and can become just the fifth franchise in League history to push that stretch to double digits. They would join the Canadiens (17 GP from 1963-64 – 1979-80), Red Wings (15 GP from 1940-41 – 1954-55), Bruins (12 GP from 1987-88 – 1998-99) and Stars (10 GP from 1996-97 – 2006-07).

STARS LOOK TO CONTINUE TO SHINE IN OPENERS

* Minnesota goaltender **Marc-Andre Fleury** is 10-7 in his team's season-opening games. Should he start and backstop the Wild past the Blue Jackets on Oct. 10, he would surpass **Curtis Joseph** (10 in 13 GP) and **Martin Brodeur** (10 in 18 GP) for the most such wins in NHL history. Should Fleury – the <u>second-winningest goaltender</u> in <u>NHL history</u> – register a shutout in that contest, he would tie **Glenn Hall** (3 SO in 11 GP) and **Jacques Plante** (3 SO in 12 GP) for the most in season-opening games in NHL history. * Alex Ovechkin (13-11—24), set to skate in his 20th season, is one of two active players (also Anze Kopitar: 9-14—23 in 17 GP) with at least 20 career points in season-opening games and 10 career goals in such contests (also Auston Matthews: 12-3—15 in 7 GP). The Capitals' captain can tie Michel Goulet (14 in 13 GP) and Dino Ciccarelli (14 in 16 GP) for the most career goals in season-opening games in NHL history should he find the back of the net against the Devils on Oct. 12. Finding the score sheet on Oct. 12 would also make Ovechkin the 10th player in League history with at least 25 career points in season-opening contests.

* Ovechkin also joins elite company in NHL history on another list as the puck drops for 2024-25. The No. 1 pick in the 2004 NHL Draft is set to captain the franchise for a 16th consecutive season dating to 2009-10 and tie **Joe Sakic** (16 from 1992-93 – 2008-09 w/ COL) for the third-longest stretch in NHL history. Longtime rival **Sidney Crosby** enters the year as Penguins captain for the 18th consecutive year and moved within one of **Steve Yzerman** (19 from 1986-87 – 2005-06 w/ DET) as the longest-tenured captain in League history.

* **Kyle Connor** enters 2024-25 riding an active six-game goal streak in season-opening games dating to 2018-19 – tied with **Cam Atkinson** (2014-15 – 2019-20), **Yvan Cournoyer** (1973-74 – 1978-79) and **Mud Bruneteau** (1940-41 – 1945-56) for the longest such streak in NHL history. Should he find the back of the net against the Oilers on Oct. 9, he would become the first player in League history to score in seven straight season-opening contests.

* Oilers forward **Leon Draisaitl**, Predators forward **Filip Forsberg**, Canadiens forward **Patrik Laine** and Maple Leafs defenseman **Morgan Rielly** have collected at least one point in each of their team's past eight seasonopening games dating to 2016-17 – the NHL's longest active stretch. The League's lengthiest stretch of



consecutive season-opening games with a point is shared by **Vincent Lecavalier** (11 GP from 2002-03 – 2013-14) and **Viktor Kozlov** (11 GP from 1997-98 – 2008-09).

* Auston Matthews scored a hat trick to begin the 2023-24 campaign – his second time scoring three-plus goals in a season opener (4 in 2016-17). Should he achieve the feat again on Oct. 9, he would become the first player in NHL history to score a hat trick on at least three different season openers and the second to do so in back-to-back campaigns (also **Cam Neely** in 1994-95 & 1995-96).

* The Sharks selected **Macklin Celebrini** with the No. 1 pick in the 2024 NHL Draft. Should Celebrini crack the club's opening-night roster, he can become the 10th No. 1 pick to score in their first season-opening game and the seventh to register multiple points in that scenario. Toronto's **Auston Matthews** (No. 1 in 2016 by TOR) is the last player to achieve both 4-0—4 on Oct. 12, 2016.
