

Connor McDavid Vying for Ninth 100-Point Season

Entering Feb. 25, 2026

* **Connor McDavid** can become the third player in [NHL history](#) to record at least nine career 100-point seasons, following **Wayne Gretzky** (15) and **Mario Lemieux** (10). McDavid would pass **Marcel Dionne** (8) on the all-time list.


* McDavid can become the eighth player in NHL history with at least [six consecutive 100-point seasons](#), and first since **Steve Yzerman** did so 33 years ago. McDavid would match the second longest stretch of consecutive 100-point seasons in NHL history, behind only **Wayne Gretzky** (13 from 1979-80 to 1991-92).

* McDavid can be the first NHL player to 100 points in a season for the sixth time in his career (also 2022-23, 2021-22, 2020-21, 2017-18 & 2016-17). The only players to be the first to 100 points in a season at least six times are **Wayne Gretzky** (9x), **Mario Lemieux** (6x) and **Phil Esposito** (6x).

* McDavid had 96 points before heading to Milan (58 GP), the most before any Olympic break. Two of five points leaders before past Olympic breaks went on to claim the [Art Ross Trophy](#): **Sidney Crosby** in 2013-14 and **Jarome Iginla** in 2001-02. **Alex Ovechkin** (2009-10), **Jaromir Jagr** (2005-06) and **Teemu Selanne** (1997-98) were all overtaken after the break.

* McDavid can reach the 100-point plateau in 60 games or fewer for the fourth time in his career. The only players to achieve the feat four or more times are **Wayne Gretzky** (13x), **Mario Lemieux** (8x) and **Phil Esposito** (5x).

* Entering Feb. 25, McDavid has led the NHL in points ([using Art Ross Trophy tie-breaking criteria](#)) for 28 game days this season. A full breakdown so far in 2025-26: **Nathan MacKinnon** (60 game days), **Jack Eichel** (21 game days), **Mark Scheifele** (3 game days), **Macklin Celebrini** (2 game days), **Nick Schmaltz** (2 game days) and **Justin Brazeau** (1 game day).

* McDavid can claim his sixth Art Ross Trophy in 2025-26. Only three players have as many: **Wayne Gretzky** (10), **Gordie Howe** (6) and **Mario Lemieux** (6).

* Overall, McDavid has won 14 career awards (Art Ross Trophy: 5, Ted Lindsay Award: 4, Hart Memorial Trophy: 3, Conn Smythe Trophy: 1 & Maurice "Rocket" Richard Trophy: 1). The Oilers captain can become the fifth player in NHL history to capture at least 15 individual NHL Awards, following **Wayne Gretzky** (31), **Alex Ovechkin** (19), **Bobby Orr** (17) and **Mario Lemieux** (17).

* McDavid was named MVP, Best Forward and to the All-Star Team after claiming a silver medal at his first Olympics, setting single-tournament records for [assists](#) and [points](#) by an NHL player (2-11—13 in 6 GP). He posted five straight multi-point games, the first player ever to do so at Olympics with NHL participation.
