



## 2020 DRAFT PROSPECTS: NHL TIES AND BLOODLINES

**Sanderson, Jake**  
**No. 4-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Geoff**, was a second-round selection of the Hartford Whalers in 1990 (36th overall) and recorded 355-345—700 in 1,104 career NHL games with the Whalers, Carolina Hurricanes, Vancouver Canucks, Buffalo Sabres, Columbus Blue Jackets, Phoenix Coyotes, Philadelphia Flyers and Edmonton Oilers.

**Markkanen, Juho**  
**No. 6-ranked ITL Goalie**

His father, **Jussi**, was a goaltender who was a fifth-round pick of the Edmonton Oilers in 2001 (133rd overall) and appeared in 128 regular-season games with the Oilers and New York Rangers.

**Garand, Dylan**  
**No. 6-ranked N.A. Goalie**

His cousin, **Ben Betker**, was a sixth-round pick by the Edmonton Oilers in 2013 (158th overall) and played professionally in Slovakia in 2019-20.

**Guhle, Kaiden**  
**No. 8-ranked N.A. Skater**

His brother, **Brendan**, was a second-round pick by the Buffalo Sabres in 2015 (51st overall) and appeared in 30 NHL games for the Anaheim Ducks in 2019-20.

**Malik, Nick**  
**No. 10-ranked N.A. Goalie**

His father, **Marek**, was a third-round pick by the Hartford Whalers in 1993 (72nd overall) and patrolled the blueline for 691 career regular-season games with the Whalers, Carolina Hurricanes, Vancouver Canucks, New York Rangers and Tampa Bay Lightning.

**Reichel, Lukas**  
**No. 11-ranked ITL Skater**

His father, **Martin**, is a German Hockey Hall of Fame member who was a second-round pick by the Edmonton Oilers in 1992 (37th overall) and played 20 seasons of pro hockey in Germany. His uncle, **Robert**, was a fourth-round pick by the Calgary Flames in 1989 (70th overall) who skated in 830 career NHL games with the Flames, New York Islanders, Phoenix Coyotes and Toronto Maple Leafs and won a gold medal with the Czech Republic at the 1998 Winter Olympics.

**Holloway, Dylan**  
**No. 12-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Bruce**, was a seventh-round pick by the Vancouver Canucks in 1981 (136th overall) and appeared in two NHL games with the club in 1984-85.

**Greig, Ridly**  
**No. 14-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Mark**, was a first-round pick by the Hartford Whalers in 1990 (15th overall) and skated in 125 career NHL games with the Whalers, Toronto Maple Leafs, Calgary Flames and Philadelphia Flyers.

**Barron, Justin**  
**No. 16-ranked N.A. Skater**

His brother, **Morgan**, was a sixth-round pick by the New York Rangers in 2017 (174th overall) and captained Cornell University in 2019-20 where he was named ECAC Player of the Year





**Perreault, Jacob**  
**No. 17-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Yanic**, was a third-round pick by the Toronto Maple Leafs in 1991 (47th overall) and recorded 247-269—516 in 859 career NHL games with the Maple Leafs, Los Angeles Kings, Montreal Canadiens, Nashville Predators, Phoenix Coyotes and Chicago Blackhawks.

**Jarventie, Roby**  
**No. 18-ranked ITL Skater**

His father, **Martti**, was a fourth-round pick by the Montreal Canadiens in 2001 (109th overall) and appeared in one game with the franchise in 2001-02. Martti, who patrolled the blueline for 21 seasons in Europe, is a two-time Finnish Elite League champion.

**Brisson, Brendan**  
**No. 20-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Pat**, is a former QMJHL player and current player agent whose client list includes **Sidney Crosby**, **John Tavares** and **Nathan MacKinnon**.

**Hunt, Daemon**  
**No. 25-ranked N.A. Skater**

His second-cousin, **Matt Calvert**, is a 10-season NHL veteran who skated for the Colorado Avalanche in 2019-20.

**Lyda, Blake**  
**No. 26-ranked N.A. Goalie**

His cousin, **Vernon Fiddler**, recorded 104-157—261 in 877 career regular-season games with the Nashville Predators, Phoenix Coyotes, Dallas Stars and New Jersey Devils.

**Bordeleau, Thomas**  
**No. 29-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Sebastien**, was a third-round pick by the Montreal Canadiens in 1993 (73rd overall) and recorded 37-61—98 in 251 career NHL games with Canadiens, Nashville Predators, Minnesota Wild and Phoenix Coyotes. His grandfather, **Paulin**, was a second-round pick by the Vancouver Canucks in 1973 (19th overall) and recorded 33-56—89 in 183 regular-season games with the Canucks from 1973-76.

**Chinakhov, Yegor**  
**No. 30-ranked ITL Skater**

His father, **Vitali**, was an 11th-round pick by the New York Rangers in 1991 (235th overall) who spent his entire professional hockey career playing in Russia.

**Guzda, Mack**  
**No. 31-ranked N.A. Goalie**

His cousin, **Jeff Woywitka**, was a first-round pick by the Philadelphia Flyers in 2001 (27th overall) and patrolled the blueline for 278 career regular-season games with the St. Louis Blues, Dallas Stars and New York Rangers.

**Foudy, Jean-Luc**  
**No. 33-ranked N.A. Skater**

His brother, **Liam**, was a first-round pick by the Columbus Blue Jackets in 2018 (18th overall) and won a gold medal with Team Canada at the 2020 World Junior Championship

**Kaiser, Wyatt**  
**No. 37-ranked N.A. Skater**

His grandfather, **Blane Comstock**, was a goaltender at Bemidji State University and represented Team USA at the 1975 World Championship and 1976 Winter Olympics. His uncle, **Earl Anderson**, was a fifth-round pick by the Detroit Red Wings in 1971 (58th overall) and skated in 109 career NHL games with the Red Wings and Boston Bruins.





**Finley, Jack**  
**No. 38-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Jeff**, was a third-round pick by the New York Islanders in 1985 (55th overall) and patrolled the blueline for 708 career NHL games with the Islanders, Philadelphia Flyers, Winnipeg Jets, Phoenix Coyotes, New York Rangers and St. Louis Blues. He is currently a scout in the Jets organization.

**Evangelista, Luke**  
**No. 39-ranked N.A. Skater**

His second-cousin, **Brendan Shanahan**, was a first-round pick by the New Jersey Devils in 1987 (2nd overall) and recorded 656-698—1,354 in 1,524 regular-season games with the Devils, St. Louis Blues, Hartford Whalers, Detroit Red Wings and New York Rangers. The two-time Stanley Cup champion and Hockey Hall of Fame member is currently the president and alternate governor of the Toronto Maple Leafs.

**Tuch, Luke**  
**No. 40-ranked N.A. Skater**

His brother, **Alex**, was a first-round pick by the Minnesota Wild in 2014 (18th overall) and has skated for the Golden Knights in each of the past three seasons

**Tarnstrom, Oliver**  
**No. 47-ranked ITL Skater**

His father, **Dick**, was a defenseman who was an 11th-round pick by the New York Islanders in 1994 (272nd overall) and recorded 35-105—140 in 306 regular-season games with the Islanders, Pittsburgh Penguins, Edmonton Oilers and Columbus Blue Jackets.

**Benning, Michael**  
**No. 57-ranked N.A. Skater**

His brother, **Matt**, was a sixth-round pick by the Boston Bruins in 2012 (175th overall) and has skated for the Edmonton Oilers in each of the past four seasons. His uncle, Jim, is the general manager of the Vancouver Canucks.

**Hanas, Cross**  
**No. 58-ranked N.A. Skater**

His cousin, **Kale Clague**, was a second-round pick by the Los Angeles Kings in 2016 (51st overall) who appeared in four NHL games with the franchise in 2019-20.

**Cardwell, Ethan**  
**No. 70-ranked N.A. Skater**

His grandfather, **Steve**, was a fifth-round pick by the Pittsburgh Penguins in 1970 and skated in 53 games for the Penguins across three seasons from 1970-73.

**Mancini, Vittorio**  
**No. 82-ranked ITL Skater**

His father, **Bob**, scouted for the Quebec Nordiques and Edmonton Oilers and served as Oilers development coach from 2007-09. Robert's wide array of experience has seen him serve as a head coach or assistant coach in the NCAA and OHL as well as for USA Hockey and South Africa's national team.

**Robins, Tristen**  
**No. 86-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Trevor**, was a goaltender in the San Jose Sharks association from 1993-94 to 1995-96.

**Styf, Hugo**  
**No. 88-ranked ITL Skater**

His father, **Par**, was a ninth-round pick by the Philadelphia Flyers in 1997 (240th overall) who had a 14-season professional career in Sweden.





**Rolston, Ryder**  
**No. 102-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Brian**, is a Stanley Cup champion (1995 w/ NJD) who was a first-round pick of the New Jersey Devils in 1991 (11th overall) and recorded 342-419—761 in 1,256 career regular-season games with the Devils, Colorado Avalanche, Boston Bruins, Minnesota Wild and New York Islanders.

**McGuire, Ryan**  
**No. 105-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Pierre**, is an NHL analyst on NBC and a former coach and scout who won the Stanley Cup as an assistant coach with the Pittsburgh Penguins in 1992 and served as head coach of the Hartford Whalers in 1993-94.

**Juhlin, Eric**  
**No. 107-ranked ITL Skater**

His father, **Patrik**, was a second-round pick by the Philadelphia Flyers in 1989 (34th overall) and skated in 56 games with the franchise from 1994-96.

**Andersson, Noah**  
**No. 120-ranked ITL Skater**

His father, **Niklas**, was a fourth-round pick by the Quebec Nordiques in 1989 (68th overall) and skated in 164 career NHL games with the Nordiques, New York Islanders, San Jose Sharks and Calgary Flames. His brother, **Lias**, was a first-round pick by the New York Rangers in 2017 (seventh overall) and has appeared in 66 regular-season games with the franchise over the past three seasons.

**Langenbrunner, Mason**  
**No. 131-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Jamie**, is a two-time Stanley Cup Champion (1999 w/ DAL and 2003 w/ NJD) who was a second-round pick of the Dallas Stars in 1993 (35th overall) and recorded 243-420—663 in 1,109 regular-season games with the Stars, New Jersey Devils and St. Louis Blues.

**Ivan, Ivan**  
**No. 135-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Marek**, was a ninth-round pick of the St. Louis Blues in 1997 (244th overall) who had a 22-season playing career with stops in the AHL, ECHL, Czech Republic, Germany, United Kingdom, Slovakia, Poland and Italy.

**Sacco, David**  
**No. 141-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Dave**, was a 10th-round pick of the Toronto Maple Leafs in 1988 (195th overall) and appeared in 35 NHL games with the Maple Leafs and Anaheim Ducks. His uncle, **Joe**, was a fourth-round pick by the Maple Leafs in 1987 and skated in 738 career regular-season games with the Maple Leafs, Ducks, New York Islanders, Washington Capitals and Philadelphia Flyers.

**Weight, Danny**  
**No. 142-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Doug**, is a Stanley Cup champion (2006 w/ CAR) who was a second-round pick by the New York Rangers in 1990 (34th overall) and recorded 278-755—1,033 in 1,238 career regular-season games with the Rangers, Edmonton Oilers, St. Louis Blues, Carolina Hurricanes, Anaheim Ducks and New York Islanders.

**Kuntar, Trevor**  
**No. 143-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Les**, was a goaltender who was selected in the sixth round by the Montreal Canadiens in 1987 (122nd overall) and appeared in six games with the franchise in 1993-94.



**Aucoin, Kyle**  
**No. 158-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Adrian**, was a fifth-round pick by the Vancouver Canucks in 1992 (117th overall) and patrolled the blueline for 1,108 career regular-season games with the Canucks, Tampa Bay Lightning, New York Islanders, Chicago Blackhawks, Calgary Flames, Phoenix Coyotes and Columbus Blue Jackets.

**Guay, Patrick**  
**No. 164-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Francois**, was an eighth-round pick by the Buffalo Sabres in 1986 (152nd overall) who appeared in one NHL game for the Sabres in 1989-90 as part of a 13-season professional career with stops in the AHL, Austria, Switzerland and Germany.

**Svejkovsky, Lukas**  
**No. 165-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Jaroslav**, was a first-round pick by the Washington Capitals in 1996 (17th overall) and appeared in 113 career regular-season games with the Capitals and Tampa Bay Lightning.

**Henault, Louka**  
**No. 171-ranked N.A. Skater**

His great-uncle, **Pierre Hamel**, was a goaltender who appeared in 69 NHL games with the Toronto Maple Leafs and Winnipeg Jets from 1974-75 to 1980-81.

**Draper, Kienan**  
**No. 186-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father is four-time Stanley Cup champion and former Selke Trophy-winner **Kris**, who registered 161-203—364 in 1,157 career regular-season games with the Winnipeg Jets and Detroit Red Wings. Kris was a third-round pick by the Jets in 1989 (62nd overall).

**Dore, Paul**  
**No. 187-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Daniel**, was a first-round pick by the Quebec Nordiques in 1988 (fifth overall) and appeared in 17 games for the Nordiques from 1989-91. Daniel is currently an amateur scout for the New York Rangers.

**Morrison, Logan**  
**No. 190-ranked N.A. Skater**

His uncle, **John Cullen**, skated in 621 career regular-season games with the Pittsburgh Penguins, Hartford Whalers, Toronto Maple Leafs and Tampa Bay Lightning while registering 187-363—550. His grandfather, **Barry Cullen**, appeared in 218 regular-season games with the Maple Leafs and Detroit Red Wings from 1955-60.

**Toporowski, Luke**  
**No. 191-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Kerry**, was a fourth-round pick by the San Jose Sharks in 1991 (67th overall) and played 12 seasons of professional hockey in the IHL, AHL, UHL and ECHL. His uncle, **Shayne**, was a second-round pick by the Los Angeles Kings in 1993 (42nd overall) and appeared in three games with the Toronto Maple Leafs in the 1996-97 season.

**Campbell, Seamus**  
**No. 195-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Jim**, was a second-round pick by the Montreal Canadiens in 1991 (28th overall) who recorded 61-75—136 in 285 career regular-season games with the Anaheim Ducks, St. Louis Blues, Canadiens, Chicago Blackhawks, Florida Panthers and Tampa Bay Lightning. His uncle, **Ed**, was an eighth-round pick by the New York Rangers in 1993 (190th overall) and had a 15-season professional career with stops in the AHL, IHL, UHL, ECHL, Italy, SPHL, CHL and FPHL.





**Karpa, Zakary**  
**No. 199-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **David**, was a fourth-round pick by the Quebec Nordiques in 1991 (68th overall) and patrolled the blueline for 557 career regular-season games with the Nordiques, Anaheim Ducks, Carolina Hurricanes and New York Rangers.

**Miller, Christian**  
**No. 205-ranked N.A. Skater**

His father, **Kris**, was a fourth-round pick by the Montreal Canadiens in 1987 (80th overall) and had an 11-season professional career with stops in the AHL, IHL, ECHL, United Kingdom and Switzerland. His uncle, **Kurt**, was a sixth-round pick by the St. Louis Blues in 1990 (117th overall) and had a 10-season professional career with stops in the AHL, ECHL, UHL, IHL, Germany and Switzerland.
