## PANTHERS' WEEGAR FINED FOR HIGH-STICKING

**NEW YORK (May 9, 2021)** -- Florida Panthers defenseman **MacKenzie Weegar** has been fined \$5,000, the maximum allowable under the Collective Bargaining Agreement, for high-sticking Tampa Bay Lightning forward **Mathieu Joseph** during NHL Game No. 857 in Sunrise, Fla., on Saturday, May 8, the National Hockey League's Department of Player Safety announced today.

The incident occurred at 18:42 of the third period. Weegar was assessed a minor penalty for roughing.

The money goes to the Players' Emergency Assistance Fund.
