8 – The most birth countries represented on a single roster, with the Ducks (Canada – 8; United States – 6; Czechia – 2; Russia – 2; Finland – 1; France – 1; Sweden – 1; Switzerland – 1) and Kraken (Canada – 9; United States – 6; Sweden – 2; Austria – 1; Denmark – 1; Finland – 1; France – 1; Germany – 1) leading the list
